DEATH IS CERTAIN FOR ALL OF US.

IN TODAY’S WORLD, DEALING WITH DEATH IS COMPLEX AND CONFUSING.

- *Life spans are increasing.*

- *Medical technology is advancing.*

- *Ethics of death are murky.*

THE BIBLE HELPS NAVIGATE THE CONFUSION.

- *Death is an enemy who will be defeated (I Corinthians 15.26; Hebrews 2:14-15; John 11).*

- *Suffering should be respected, not avoided at all costs (Romans 8:23-25; II Corinthians 5:1-10).*

- *There is an appropriate time to let go (Psalm 116.15).*

- *The certainty of death is a coach who teaches us how to live well (Ecclesiastes 7:2, 4).*
