Equipping Leaders in Kinshasa

In April, Samaritan Strategy, in partnership with CECU and ReachAfrica, held a Vision Conference in Masina/Kinshasa. The conference was facilitated by Harvest and Samaritan



Strategy facilitators. 50 people were trained, but 30 (8 women and 22 men) have been selected for a training of trainers session that will be held in the near future.
